Conditions:

1) Buck and Doe owner both state that the Buck and Doe are healthy, are in breedable condition, and are free from any know illnesses, diseases, infections, abscesses, worms, mange, lice, fungus. Feet should be trimmed before doe is delivered to breeder.

2) If the doe does not get bred, the doe may be brought back for rebreeding. If it is determined that the doe is infertile, the breeding can be used on another doe owned by the original owner of the doe at the time of the first breeding.

Note: There are two categories of goats...

1. "Alpine Category" – This category is made up of mostly the Dairy Breeds. These types of goats are usually seasonal breeders. Every 21 days a doe might come into "season" between the months of August through January.

2. "Equatorial Category" – This category of goat usually comes from climates that are hot all year long. Goats in this category usually breed all year long. These types of goat breeds of the meat variety such as Spanish, Boers, Pygmies and some Nubians can be as well.

3) I do not guarantee a live birth or that all kid(s) will survive. Often doe's have twins or triplets and some do not live. I just guarantee the breeding.

4) Payment is due at the time the doe is brought to the breeders. The breeding fee and enough feed (1 bale a week) or money for 6 weeks is due at the time the doe is delivered to the breeder. Doe should remain for up to 8 weeks or more to make sure she has been bred. but that is up to the owner to decide.

5) All reasonable care will be taken to provide a safe environment for the doe while she is in care of the breeder. Breeder is not responsible for any accidental death, injury, or illness of the doe. All veterinary expenses incurred by the doe are the responsibility of the doe's owner.

6) If doe owner fails to pay any additional fees or to pick up the doe in a reasonable time after the pre-paid breeding stay time is up. The breeder has the right to sell the doe for compensation of charges.

7) If doe needs to be picked up and/or delivered owner will pay an additional \$40/hour driving/pickup fee, both directions.
